Show Checklist

While not a complete list, it hopefully this will give you an idea of how pack and plan for your trip! Have fun!

Horse Apparel / Needs

- 2 halters, one spare
- Lead ropes, stud chain
- Head bumper, if needed
- Shipping boots or leg bandages, wraps and bell boots
- Exercise boots - bell, gallop, jumping if normally used
- Travel sheet, rug
- Stable wraps
- Extra shoes (drilled and tapped)
- Tail bandage
- Neck "sleazy" to keep braids clean (if new, wash first to keep color from running)
- Cooler, Stable Blanket
- Poultice
- Liniment
- Vet Wrap
- Duct Tape
- First aid kit

Grooming

- Tote with brushes, hoof picks, etc.
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Stain Remover
- Washing buckets
- Sponges
- Sweat scraper
- Towels/rags
- Fly spray
- Hoof oil/polish
- Show Sheen or other hair polish
- Mane/tail brush
- Mane pulling comb
- Braiding kit
- Step stool
- Braiding Apron

Feed/Water

Full hay bag for trailer
Filled water jugs for trailer journey
Hay for stall/while on show grounds & return trip home
Regular grain portions – labeled & in tupperware/ziplocs
Measuring scoop, if necessary
Supplements, in labeled containers
Treats
Electrolytes, salt
Grain & water buckets plus hooks for hanging

Tack

Saddles – dressage, jumping
Girths – dressage, jumping & include spare
Stirrup irons & leathers, include extra leathers
Breastplate
Martingale
Saddle pads, one with DHF logo
Bridle, bits, reins – include extra reins
Legal length dressage whip, no longer than 47.2” including lash
Jumping bats (Eventing)
Body protection vest (Eventing)
Polo bandages
Lunge line, side reins & lunge whip

Rider

Breeches (white for dressage, any color for stadium jumping/cross country)
Belt, if breeches have belt loops
Shirt(s) (white and any color with sleeves for cross country; light color short sleeves if hot weather judges allow jackets to be optional)
Riding underwear, non-chafing, no thick hems/seams along legs to avoid blisters
Sports bra, pack spares
Boot and casual/sport socks
Jacket (black)
Boots and polishing rag (field or dress)
Boot pulls & Boot jack
Spurs and straps
Stock tie and pins
Helmet **ASTM/SEI certified riding helmet with buckled chin strap**
Hair bow, hair net, pins, elastics, brush, spray
Gloves (white for dressage, black for eventing)
Dressage whip
Rain gear, winter wear, hand/toe warmers
Toiletries
Towels/Rags

Makeup, mirror
Casual clothes, including loose fitting pants, i.e. sweat pants, scrubs
Barn boots
First aid kit
Sunscreen
Lint roller
Garment bag, optional

General Needs

Coggins test
Show paperwork
Dressage tests, Rule book(s), USEA Omnibus
Medical Arm Band
Cell phone, batteries or charger
Notepad, pens
Emergency numbers
Snacks and drinks
Cooler and ice
Cash, credit card
Kleenex
Paper bags
Paper Towels
Folding chairs

Stall Management

Bedding, bagged shavings or straw (shavings are available and expensive at show grounds)
Check stall for sharp edges, safety concerns
Double-end snaps, bucket hooks
Hose, water control spout
Broom, shovel
Pitchfork, Manure basket
Stall guard
Stall fan, extension cord & bungee cords
